University Place Veterans Memorial seeking general contractor

The University Place Veterans Memorial committee is seeking responses from interested general contractors who may live and/or have their offices located in University Place or surrounding communities to provide donated project management and coordination of the work for the proposed new veterans memorial project to be located in the City of University Place. The selected contractor will be expected to solicit bids from select subcontractors and suppliers, with an expectation that some or all subcontractor labor and/or materials would be donated to this high profile community project. The UPVM committee will contract directly with any non-donated subcontractors, and will pay directly for any non-donated supplier materials. Volunteer labor

will be provided by community volunteers for general manual labor tasks, and the contractor will be asked to coordinate and schedule this work with other work tasks of the project. The contractor may also provide some of the construction labor as he/she may choose.

The selected contractor shall be licensed to work in the City of University Place, shall pay for any/all permits required for the project, shall be able to provide a construction bond for the contracted work, shall provide a right-of-way work bond as may be required by the City of University Place, and shall provide general construction liability insurance as required by the City of University Place. The UPVM committee will reimburse the selected contractor for his/her project related expenses.

Selection of the contractor will be based on his/her interest in this community based project and by interview with the UPVM committee. It is the UPVM committee's desire to select the contractor by August 1, 2010. Interested parties

are requested to submit a letter of interest to the UPVM Committee at 3800 Bridgeport Way West #405, University Place, WA 98466.
